For some subjects additional books may need to be purchased for additional practice.

For the French and German classes the choice of book depends on the language level that the students are in. The language levels will be assessed during the first 2 weeks of school. The teachers will tell the students which books to buy at the end of September.

Obligatory class material & specific material for the different classes:

Pencil case with pencils, coloured pencils, rubber, pen, scissors and a glue stick. Students also need paper, file folders, and A4 paper sheets (for tests/exams) – each teacher will inform the students about their materials. Some teachers will require special material (calculators, rulers, etc.) and will inform the students during the first lesson.

Photocopies:

Photocopies made by the teacher and which are distributed to the students are payable. The teachers customarily collect money at the end of each term/semester for this.

P.E.: Indoors or outdoors:

- Shorts or leggings, sports shirt. **Tank tops** (sleeveless or spaghetti strap tank tops) **are not allowed**.
- Clean sports socks or ankle socks and shoes, adapted to the gym - **no sandals or espadrilles** (to avoid sprained ankles).

In the swimming pool:

- Swim suit and cap, swimming goggles, soap and towel
- Water sandals ("Waasserschlappen") to avoid plantar warts.

Swim caps are available for sale (€2) or for rent (€0.50) (see swim instructor). If your child does not participate in the swimming lesson, he/she is to **wear sports clothes** (shorts and t-shirts) while waiting at the sitting area around the pool. Students need a **valid excuse** (written by their parents) if they do not participate in swimming lessons. **If they missed too many, they have to stay one afternoon to catch up with the swimming lessons.**

Please inform the sports staff and the homeroom teacher if the student cannot swim, or swim well!
